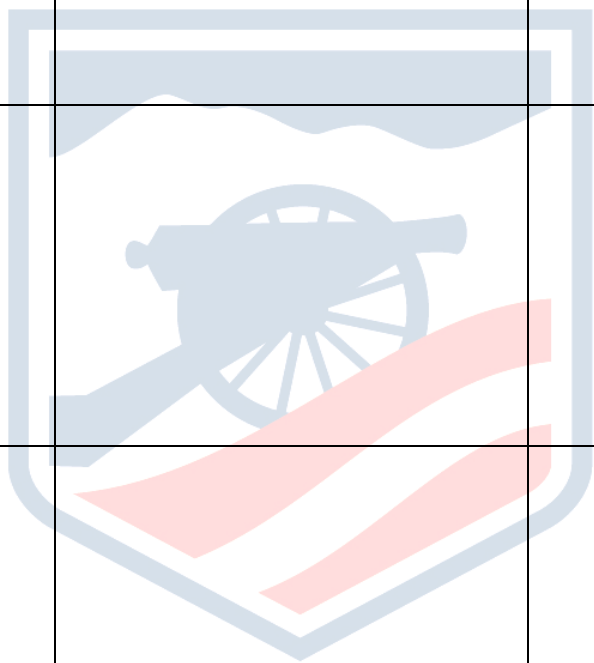
Definition “Primary Source”: the raw materials of history—original documents and objects that were created at the time under study (Library of Congress)
